Free, and yours in about a minute.

Point your phone's camera here and tap the link that pops up:



Or type this into Safari:

What you need: an iPhone or iPad on iOS 15.1 or later, and about 210 MB of space.

What it costs: nothing. No account, no sign-up, no ads.

One thing to remember: once it installs, **open it, close it fully, and open it again.** It picks up its newest updates on that second launch.

Three steps, and you're in

1

Scan the code on the front page with your camera, or search **Ilona Andrews** in the App Store.

Look for the lion — the same one from ilona-andrews.com.

2

Tap Get, then confirm with Face ID, Touch ID, or your password.

It's free, and there's nothing to subscribe to.

3

Open the app, close it fully, then open it again. Welcome to the Horde.

This one matters: the app fetches its newest updates in the background and applies them on the **second** launch. Two opens and you're fully up to date.

If it asks about notifications, saying yes gets you the Quote of the Day and new blog posts. You can change your mind any time in Settings.

What's inside

- ◆ Every series and every book, with reading orders and where to buy
- ◆ The interactive Map of Kair Toren, with Sushi's notes on every location
- ◆ The Maggie the Undying encyclopedia — cast, families, orders, glossary
- ◆ The free fiction library, with read-aloud
- ◆ The blog and its comments, right in the app
- ◆ BDH Bingo, quotes, quizzes, and achievements to chase
- ◆ Official character portraits by the artists who painted them
- ◆ Dark mode, large text, and VoiceOver throughout

Reading progress stays yours. Favorites, badges, and progress live on your device — there's no account and nothing is collected.

Something acting odd? Same trick as day one: **close the app fully and open it again.** Updates arrive quietly and apply on the next launch, so the second open is the one that counts. Still stuck? **More** → **Send Feedback** goes straight to the developer.
